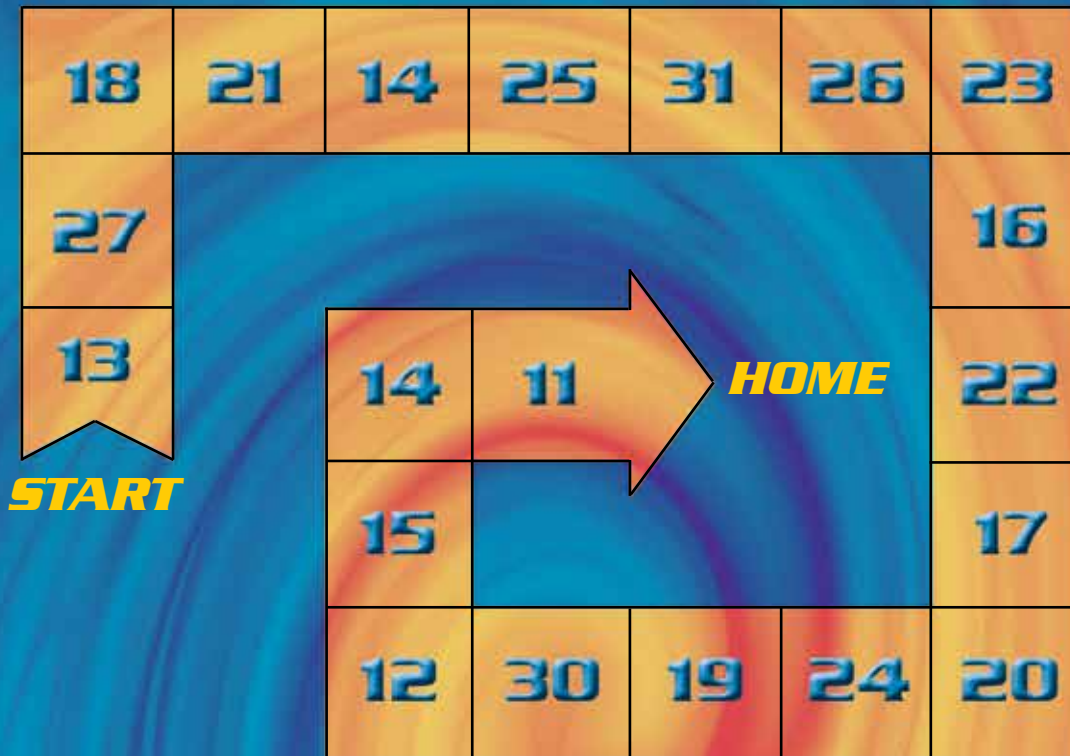


It Remains to Be Seen

You need a set of digit cards (1–9) a classmate
 a different-coloured counter for each player



Game

Shuffle the digit cards and put them face down in a pile.

Put your counters on 13 (the start).

Take turns to turn over the top digit card.

Divide the number your counter is on by the number on the card.

If there is a remainder, move your counter forward the same number of spaces as the remainder. If there is no remainder, your counter does not move.

Put your card back on the bottom of the pile. Shuffle the cards occasionally.

To get home, a player must move the exact number of spaces left.
If your remainder is too great to do this, you do not move.

The first player home wins.
