

# COCO CHOCO



## Describe your mocktail

Creamy, chocolatey, coconutty goodness.

Remember those coconut-wrapped -in-chocolate *Bounty Bars*?

This is a *Bounty Bar* in a glass!

## Ingredients

120ml milk  
 15ml coconut cream  
 30ml chocolate syrup  
 15ml cream  
 ice  
 lemon slice, mint, cherry

## Instructions

Place ice in a shaker. Add other ingredients. Shake well. Pour into cocktail glass and garnish

## Make a litre!

667ml milk  
 83ml coconut cream  
 167ml chocolate syrup  
 83ml cream  
 ice  
 lemon slices, mint, cherries

## Shop for a party!

*Mix the ingredients in the ratio*

**1:1:2:8**

For every ml of cream, you will need a ml of coconut cream, 2ml of chocolate syrup and 8ml of milk.

*This shopping list will make up to 20 Coco Chocos. That's a cost of \$0.61c each.*

*The limiting factor is the chocolate syrup. If you reduced the amount of chocolate syrup to 25ml you could get 24 drinks. You'd have plenty of cream left over, so you could also make it 20ml of cream to make up to 25 drinks. So for slightly less chocolate and slightly more cream you could get a maximum of 24 drinks. That would be a cost of \$0.51c each.*

*Because the numbers are so close, as a bonus you could probably just pour all the ingredients into a bucket of ice, give it a good mix and have 24 drinks made in less than 5 minutes.*

### Go organic!

| Organic Ingredients       | Size   | Quantity | Price per unit | Number of drinks  | Cost           |
|---------------------------|--------|----------|----------------|-------------------|----------------|
| Lewis Road milk           | 1500ml | 2        | 7.00           | 25                | 14.00          |
| Ceres coconut cream       | 400ml  | 1        | 3.99           | 26                | 3.99           |
| Lewis Road cream          | 300ml  | 1        | 4.15           | 33                | 4.15           |
| Trade Aid chocolate syrup | 250ml  | 3        | 7.40           | 25                | 22.20          |

|                           |        |          |                | <b>Total cost</b> | <b>\$44.35</b> |

*The organic version will make 25 drinks for \$44.35. That's \$1.85 per drink. That's about 3 times more than the budget version.*

*The biggest cost increase was the chocolate syrup. You could make your own using organic cocoa powder (\$6.00), organic sugar (\$4.29) and water. That would save \$11.71 and make it just \$1.36 for an organic drink.*
