## On the Trail



The Seelow Scroggin Company sells a delicious trail mix in different-sized packets.

These are the proportions for each ingredient:

- $\frac{1}{4}$  peanuts
- $\frac{1}{5}$  sunflower seeds
- $\frac{1}{4}$  raisins
- $\frac{1}{5}$  dried apricots
- $\frac{1}{10}$  chocolate

Scooter Seelow uses a set of scales to help him put the right proportion of ingredients in each packet of scroggin he makes up. He starts off by making a small 100 gram packet of trail mix. He puts in:

- 25 grams of peanuts
- 20 grams of sunflower seeds
- 25 grams of raisins
- 20 grams of dried apricots
- 10 grams of chocolate
