## Target Time

You need $\square$ a dice 1 or more classmates
a photocopy of the Target game board copymaster

## Game

Play the Target game with one or more classmates.

- Each player needs a score sheet.
- There is a target number for each round. This target is shown on the score sheet at the start of each round. The target number for the first round is 6 .
- Players take turns to throw the dice 4 times. After each throw, the dice thrower writes the number shown on the dice in one of the boxes on their score sheet.

- Once a number has been recorded, it cannot be changed.
- After each player has thrown the dice 4 times, the players add up their decimal numbers.
- Each player's score is the difference between their total and the target number.
- The winner is the player with the lowest total score after 4 rounds.

I got $2.6+4.5$, which makes 7.1.
7.1 is 1.1 more than 6 , so my score is 1.1 .

I got 2.4 + 5.6, which makes 8.0.
$8-6=2$.
My score is 2 .

After you have played the game a few times, play it using different target numbers.
