## Serious Circus Sums

## Activity

The circus has come to town. Siaosi, Nio, and Sara want to go to the show with their families. They look at the admission prices to work out the best deal.

1. a. How much would it cost for 2 children and 1 adult?
b. How much would it cost for 4 children and 3 adults?
2. Sara works out the costs for all the members of each family to go to an afternoon show. Her family, including her little sister, would have to pay $\$ 27$, Nio's family would have to pay $\$ 15$, and Siaosi's family, which includes his grandfather as well as his parents, would have to pay $\$ 30$.
How many adults and children are in each family?
3. Next, Siaosi, Nio, and Sara look at evening show prices:
