Why do it?

You can help your child to practise the 5 plus addition facts.

What you need:

- Dice
- A pack of cards – use the 6, 7, 8, 9, 10 cards.

What to do:

- Shuffle the cards and deal 5 cards to each player.
- The first player rolls the dice and adds 5 to the number. Throw again if a 6 comes up. For example, if you roll a 3, then $3 + 5 = 8$. If the player has a card with that total, for example 8, she or he can put the card on the table. The next player has a turn.
- The winner is the first player to put all their cards on the table.

What to expect your child to do:

- Over time expect your child to instantly recall the addition facts of 5 plus.

Variation:

- Roll the dice and ask your child to quickly add 5 to the dice number.
- Use your home language to play this game.
