

## License Plates 2

**Purpose:**

The purpose of this activity is to help your child learn basic addition facts.

**Link to the Number Framework:**

Number Facts, Stage 5

**What you need:**

- Paper and pencil

**What to do:**

- As you drive in the car or walk beside the road, write down the numbers you see on vehicle license plates.
- Add up each of the digits to give a total. For example if the license plate has the numbers 5682, the total of the digits is  $5+6+8+2=21$ . Who can spot the car with the highest total?
- Add or subtract the digits to get as close as possible to zero. For example, if a license plate has the digits 3726, you might say " $7+2-3-6=0$ ".

**What to expect from your child:**

Your child should be able to tell you the answer to the addition facts instantly without having to count or calculate.

**Note:**
