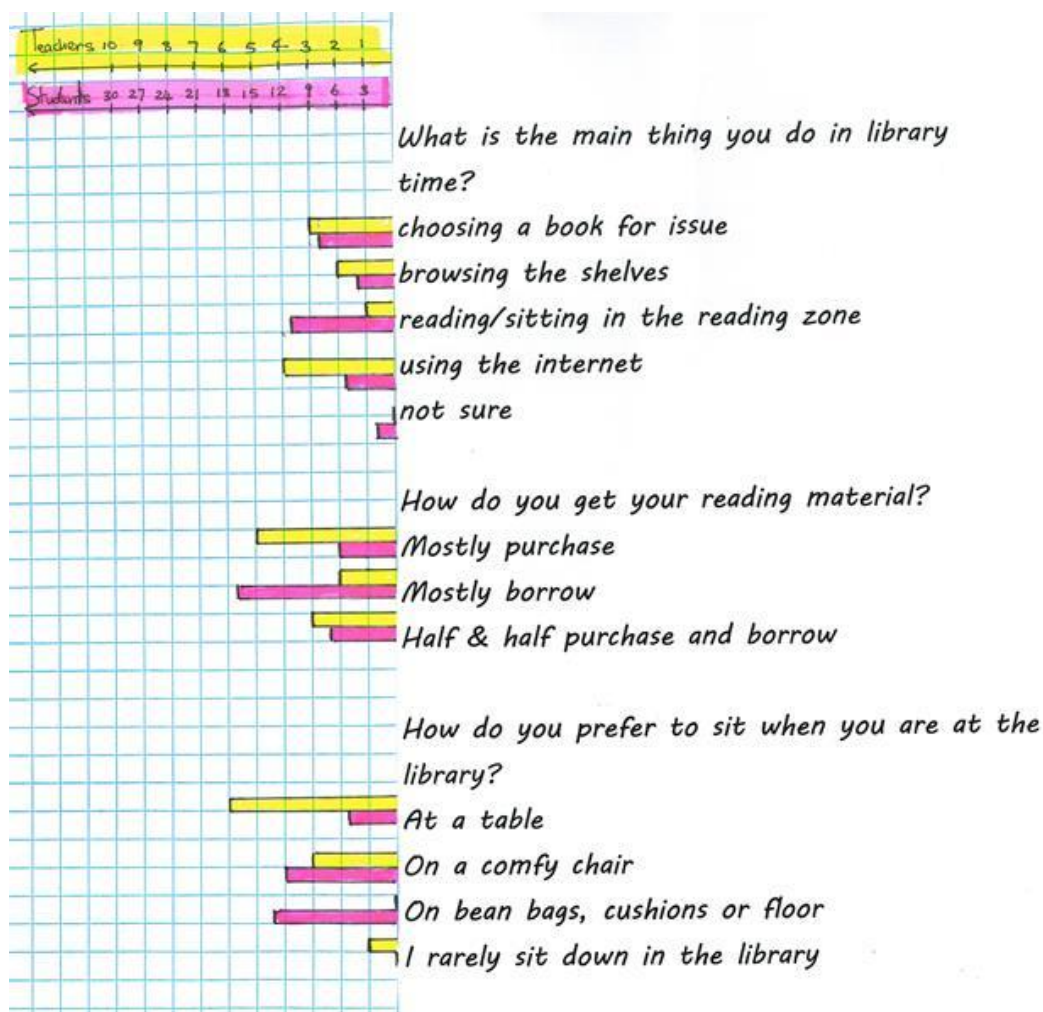


Books vs Bean Bags? Part iii
