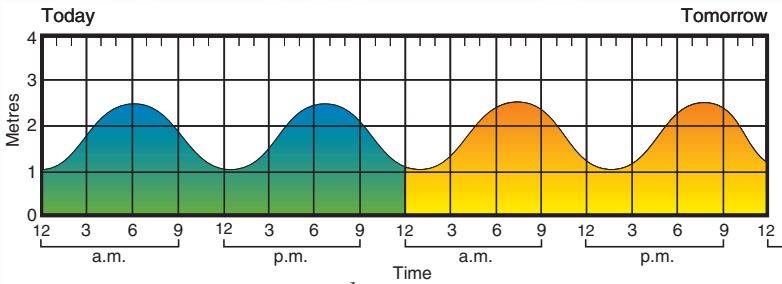


# Claws!

## Activity

The best time for people at Camp Mārama to visit the tidal rock pools is at low tide. Here is the tide timetable from today's newspaper:



1. The students need  $1\frac{1}{2}$  hours to explore the pools. When is the best time for them to do this?
2. The students from Te Kauri School find that the pools are full of crabs. There are two species of crabs in the pools. The students measure each crab to find the width of its back in millimetres. Here are life-size drawings of the crabs that they found.

Measure the crabs and present the data in a graph that can be sent to marine headquarters.
