



Hannah and Emeli use one hand each to show "High Five".

I know that 5 + 5 = 10, so half of 10 must be 5.






a. 2 + 2 =

b. double 3

c. 4 + 4 =

d. half of 6

e. half of 8



6 + 6 is the same as 5 + 5 and double 1. 5 + 5 make 10. 10 and 2 more is 12. Therefore 6 + 6 = 12.





Work with your classmate and use your fingers to work out these doubles or halves:

a. double 7

b. half of 16

c. 10 + 10 =

d. 8 + 8 =

e. half of 20

f. half of 14

g. double 9

Half of 18? Hmmm ... Well, half of 10 is 5, and half of 8 is 4, so half of 18 is 5 + 4. That's 9.
