## Money-making Mice

Key financial ideas We all need to manage our money so that we can at least cover our costs. * It's possible to earn some income from hobbies and interests.

## Game



* Place the counters on Start.
* Each player starts with $\$ 50$. Record your scores carefully on your copy of the cash-book record sheet. Ask other players for help if you need to.

| Cash-book Record Sheet |  |  |  |

| Description | Money in | Money out | Balance |

| Sell mice | $\$ 30$ |  | $\$ 80$ |
| Food bowl |  | $\$ 5$ | $\$ 75$ |

* Take turns to throw the dice and move your counter forward that number of spaces.
* Then:
* if you land on a space with a sum of money on it, add that amount to or subtract it from your total;
* if you land on a mouse wheel, do nothing;
* if you land on a piece of cheese, choose one of the options from the cheese in the centre.
* Players are out of the game if their bank balance goes below zero.
* Continue going around the mouse board until one player has a balance of exactly $\$ 200$. That person is the winner!
