

Percentages: Estimate Match

Print onto card, laminate and cut into separate cards.

To play:

For 2 to 4 players.

Cards are spread out face down.

Players take turns to select a white and a blue card.

If a player believes that the amount on the blue card is a good estimate in response to the problem posed on the white card, they declare "Match" and must explain the rationale for their 'match declaration'.

Another player verifies the declaration by using the calculator to check.

If the player's estimate is close, the player keeps the pair. If not, the cards are returned face down to the collection spread out in front of the players and the next person takes their turn.

The game continues till all cards are used.

The winner is the person with the most pairs.

Those who finish promptly can use the blank cards to create their own problems to add to the game.
