

You need: a calculator (optional)

Palindromes are words or phrases that read the same backwards as forwards. Mum, Dad, and "a Toyota" are good examples. A well-known example of a longer palindrome is "a man, a plan, a canal, Panama".

Palindromic numbers are numbers that read the same backwards as forwards, such as 22, 353, and 49 194.

You can create a palindromic number by reversing the digits in a number and adding this new number to the original number. Sometimes it can take several steps to get a palindromic number.



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
