

Game cards (back side)

A gift (usually money) to a charitable cause (Donation)	Money you earn or get from other sources apart from work (Income)	Income spent (Expenditure)	Amount of extra expenses over income (Loss)	The interest paid on the total of the capital and previous interest earned (Compound interest)
Financial protection against loss or damage (Insurance)	Regular payment for work (usually calculated by the hour) (Wage)	Promise of replacement if a product is faulty (Guarantee)	The money you make after you have paid for all your costs (Profit)	Part of a company's profits paid to shareholders (Dividend)
Money removed from a bank account (Withdrawal)	Fixed payment for work, usually paid per fortnight or month (Salary)	A sum of money paid to a person regularly (Allowance)	Account entry to record money withdrawn or spent (Debit)	Profit from investment (Return)
Money put into a bank account (Deposit)	Money invested to produce further wealth (Capital)	Plan for income and expenses over a period of time (Budget)	Account entry to record money received (Credit)	Money invested for a period of time (Term investment)
Payment made by a tenant to the owner of a property (Rent)	The amount of income earned from saving money in a bank or that you pay someone else for lending you money (Interest)	List of transactions in a bank account (Bank statement)	Money deposited for financial return (Investment)	An equal part of a company's capital (Share)
Money put away (for example, in a bank) for use at a later time (Savings)	Money paid to the government from income (Tax)	Money transferred to a different bank account on a specified day (Automatic payment)	The exchange between buyer and seller, usually money, for what is purchased (Transaction)	Payment in regular instalments for something you already have the use of (Hire purchase)
