

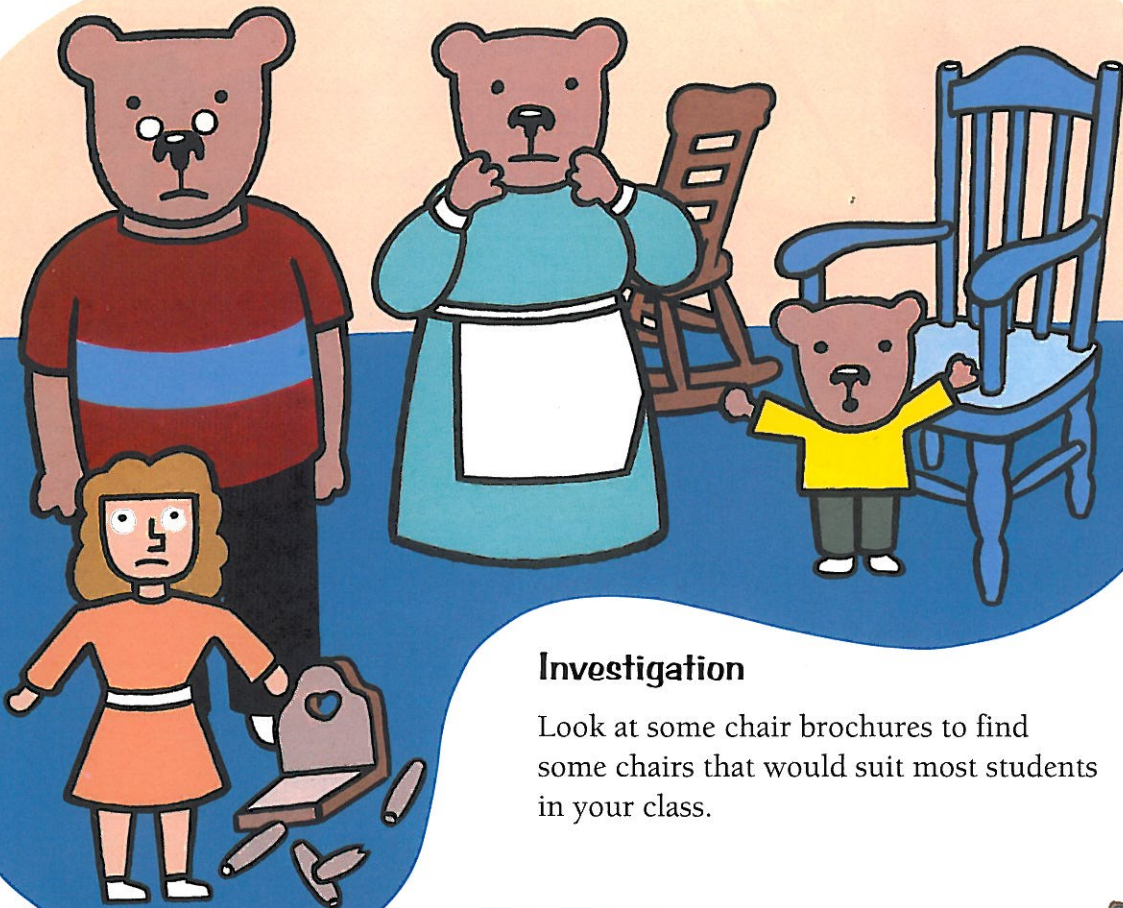
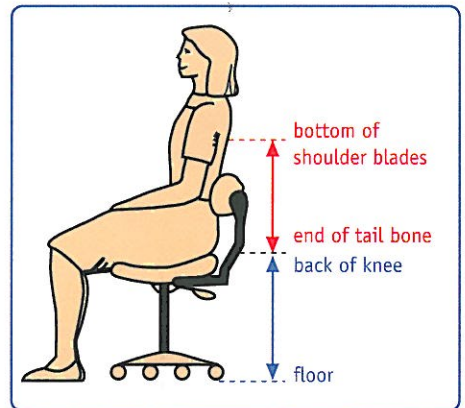
Three Chairs

Activity

In the story “Goldilocks and the Three Bears”, Goldilocks had problems finding a comfortable chair to sit in. She thought one of the chairs was the correct size for her, but it broke.

1. Discuss with a classmate how you can tell if a chair is the correct size for you.
2.
 - a. Decide what lengths have to be right if a chair is to be suitable for a person.
 - b. Measure these lengths for at least five people in your class.
 - c. Measure the chairs in your classroom.
