## Activity

Here is a way to make your own wrapping paper.
Make up a square printing-block by gluing small bits of cardboard (the pattern) onto a cardboard base.


You can make a symmetrical pattern with your printing block.


If you are using ink, roll the ink across the printing-block with a roller.


If you are using paint, brush the paint to cover the printing-block.

Press the inked or painted side of the block down on a piece of paper.
Then move it to a new place on the paper and press it down again.
Carry on moving your block and pressing it onto your paper until you have covered the paper with a pattern.
You may need to re-ink or repaint your block at times.
Below are some ways you could move the block.
