➤ Notes for parents and Activity.

The purpose of this task is to help your child to:

- practice counting accurately
- enjoy a number game

It's a variation of 'I spy'.



"I spy with my little eye **four** of these. What can I see?" (For example: you can see four kitchen chairs. Your child should look about and guess by the number clue, what you are looking at.)

Take turns to play this game, varying the numbers each time.

You might like to include some simple addition. (For example: "I spy with my little eye **three plus two** of these. What can I see?")



He tauira kōrero Māori

He aha taku karu e kite ana? E whā ēnei i tēnei rūma. He aha rā?	What is my eye seeing? There are four of these in this room. What are they?
He mea iti noa iho.	They are just small things.
E noho putu ana.	They are sitting in a pile.
E kite ana ahau i te toru tāpiri i te rua o ēnei mea. He aha rā?	I can see 3 plus 2 of these things. What are they?
