Here's what to do:

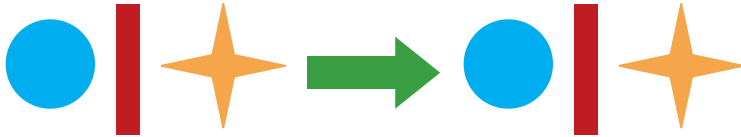
- Print the task sheet on the following page and check that your child understands what to do.

- As they work have them explain to you the pattern they are working on.



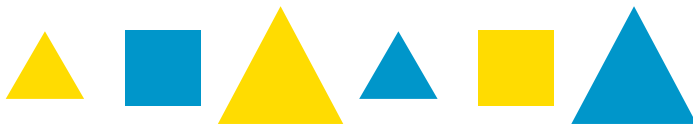
