The purpose of this task is to help your child:

- to consider and investigate the precision with which large numbers may be used around them day-to-day

Think about this:

- Children are often interested in large numbers and may frequently hear them used. However, given that the addition of one extra zero to a number increases its size tenfold, it is surprising that, as numbers 'get big', they can often be used somewhat casually.
- As this task may run over several days, first discuss it with your child and see if it's an investigation that interests them and that they would enjoy doing.
- You may need to be ready to assist with, discuss and encourage the 'research' too.
