**Question 1**

John has 23 marbles in his collection and he gives 5 to his friend Pepe.  
How many marbles does he have left?

**Question 2**

Sandu has a necklace with 28 beads on it. It breaks and 9 beads fall off.  
How many are left on the necklace?

**Question 3**

Hohepa has 15 lollies and he buys another 7. How many does he have altogether?

**Question 4**

Tracey has 27 buttons and she collects another 14. How many does she have now?

**Question 5**

Timothy has some marbles and he wins 12 more at lunchtime. Now he has 21.  
How many did he have to start with?

**Question 6**

Kate has 9 tennis balls and she collects some more at the courts. Now she has 22.  
How many more did she find?

**Question 7**

There were some pieces of fruit in the bowl. Jenny put another 7 pieces in.  
Altogether there were 23. How many pieces of fruit were in the bowl to start with?

**Question 8**

Troy has 34 sheep. He puts half of them in a another paddock. How many are in each paddock?

Nelly likes collecting stamps. She has 68 in her collection. She gets given another 17.  
How many does she have now?
